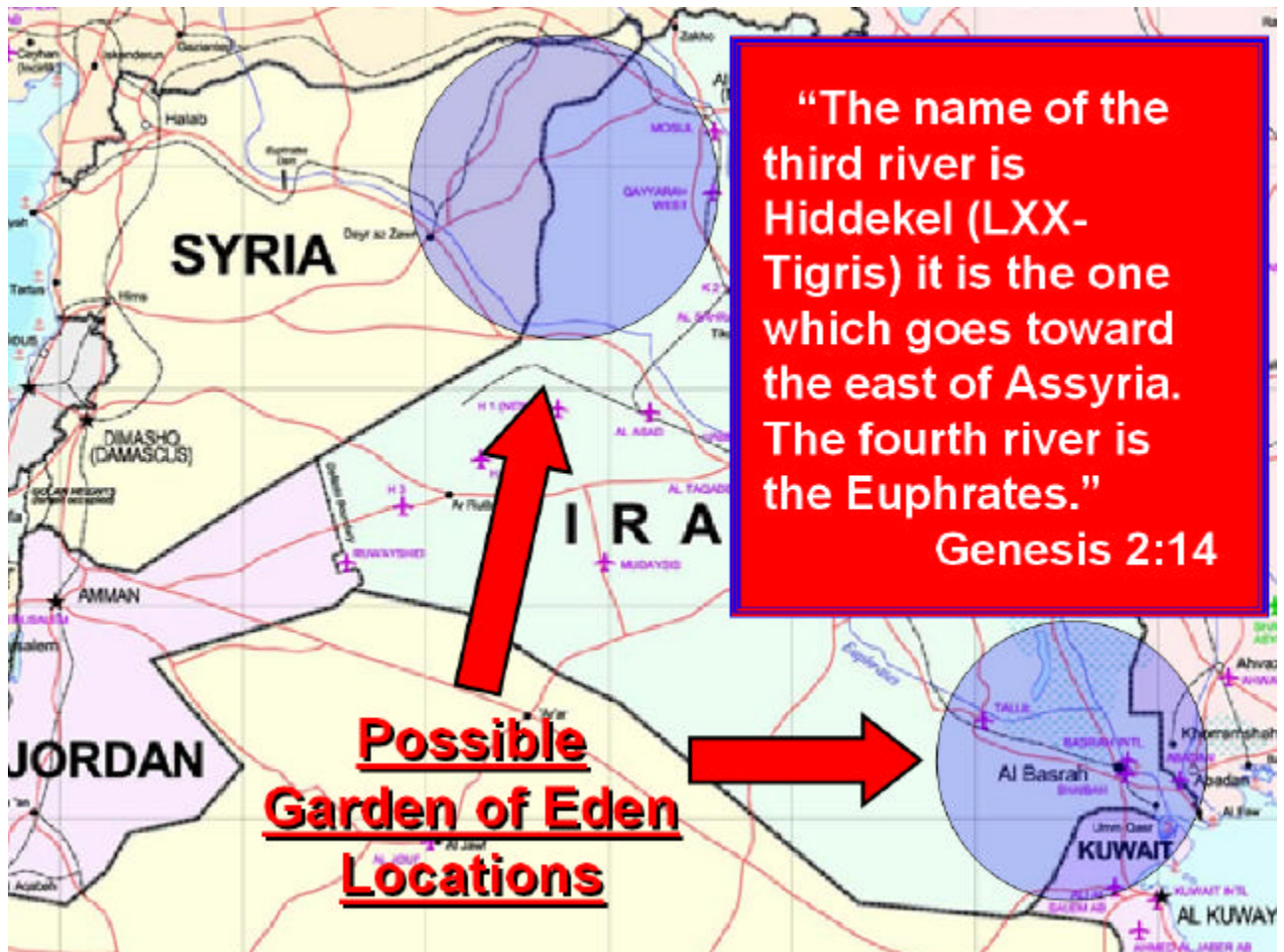
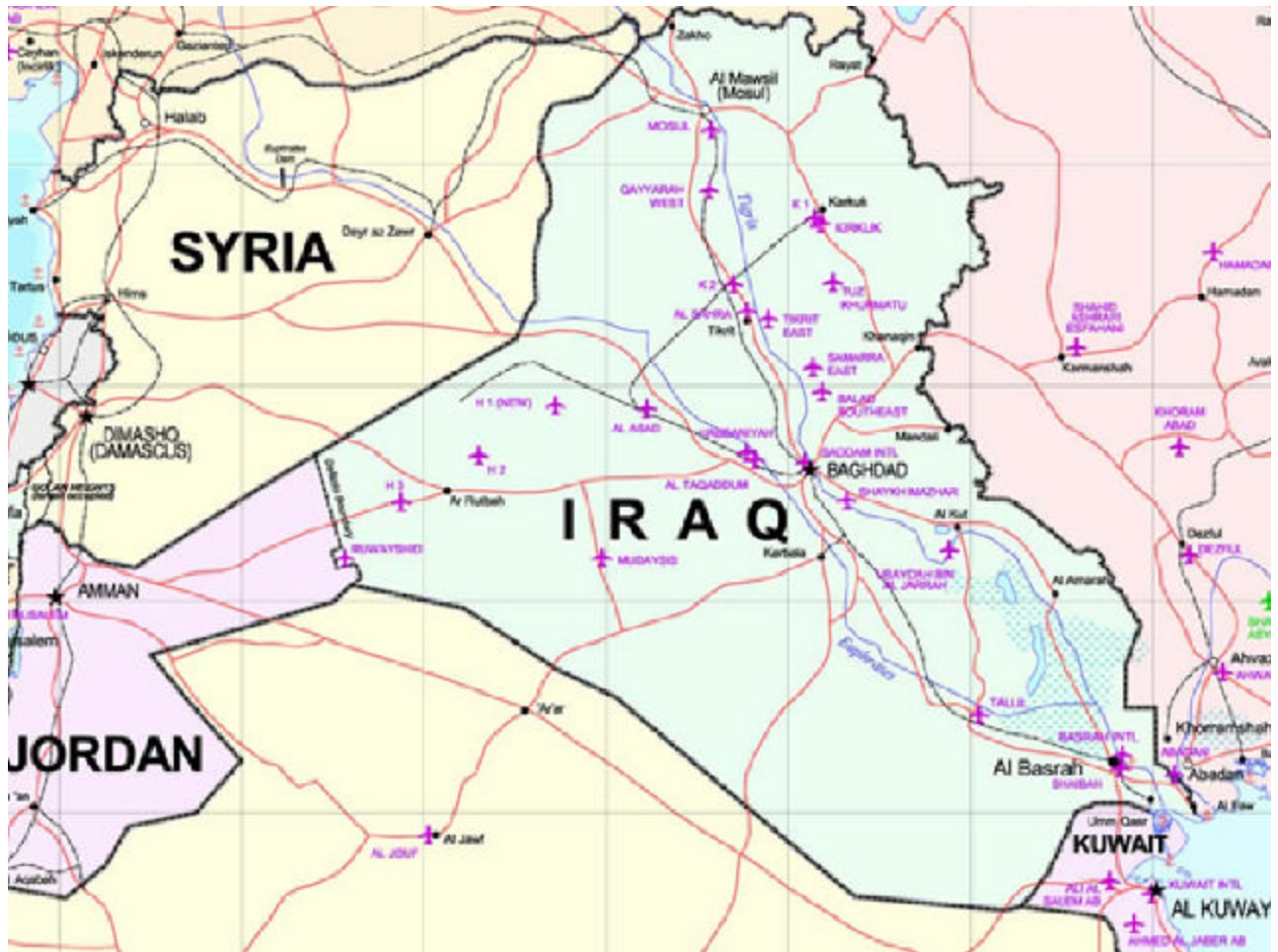
Iraq and Bible Geography

13. Shushan (Susa)







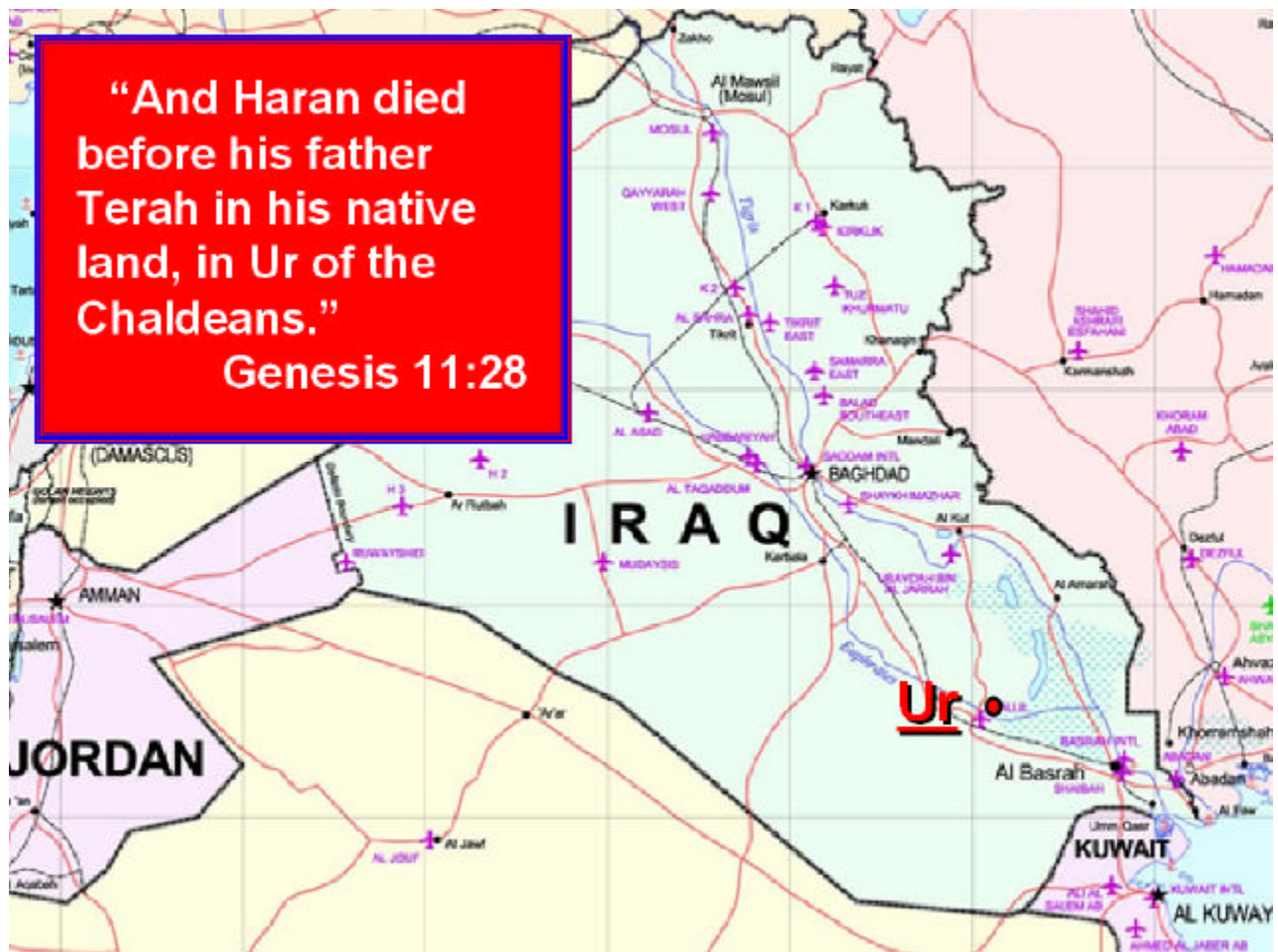
